The Master of Education in Educational Studies (MES) is a two-year, parttime, course-based program for teachers, educational administrators, and educational leaders who want to enhance their knowledge and practice in the areas of leadership and school improvement related to IB programs.

To optimize the learning experience, the program is cohort-based. Coursework is structured to allow you to build your knowledge in an area of IB education that is of particular interest to you. The MES provides you with opportunities to develop educational research skills and apply them in your educational context.

THE PROGRAM

The Master of Education in Educational Studies (MES) is structured to facilitate studying while you work: the program is blended and part-time. Ten courses are completed in sequence with a cohort of IB educators.

YEAR 1

- EDU 511 & EDU 512 online over 3 weeks in Summer Residency
- EDU 503 online in the Fall
- EDU 510 online in the Winter
- YEAR 2
- EDU 513 & EDU 514 over 3 weeks in Summer Residency
- EDU 515 online in the Fall
- EDU 900 online in the Winter

Plus two approved electives, taken at the student's discretion.
